Congress location:

The city of Eggenburg (https://www.eggenburg.at/) is climatically located between Weinviertel in the east and Waldviertel in the west, whereby the surrounding countryside is used agriculturally and the wine culture dominates towards the east. The area was continuously populated from the Neolithic period. In the 11th century a castle and a church settlement were built, which had been expanded in the 12th century to a planned castle town. In 1277 Eggenburg became a realm imperial, princely city. It is located in the area of the castle, the parish church and the main square on a granite hill, which is covered to the east by fossil marine deposits and loess and is encircled by the Schmida-River.
