FIRST (new) CIRCULAR for 2021

Subjects:

On the importance of archives, museums and collections for the development of earth sciences; Geological exploration and researchers in the Weinviertel and Waldviertel (regions of Lower Austria, Austria); Geology and Myth, Free Topics

Organizational matters:

The original date for June 2020 had to be postponed due to Corona. At the time of this new 1st circular, the circumstances for June 2021 cannot be foreseen; the organizing committee will make all preparations as may be necessary at the time. In the event of severe travel restrictions, consideration is also being given to a video conference, a meeting in which several participants, who are at different locations, can be optically and acoustically connected to the pre-day room using video technology.

In the event of a complete cancellation due to Covid19 for June 2021, there will be no further postponement. The abstract volume will be completed, printed and then sent to all registered participants who have paid the conference fee.

Conference and excursion fees paid up to now have been transferred to the new date in June 2021 or have been and will be transferred back on request.

Even those who were not registered for 2020 have the opportunity to come to the 15th ERBE Symposium in Eggenburg and take part. You are cordially invited! Please register for 2021.

A new 2nd circular is planned for around February 1, 2021.

The conference will take place in the rooms of the Krahuletz Museum (http://www.krahuletzmuseum.at/) and the municipality of Eggenburg from Sunday, June 13th to Sunday, June 20th, 2021.

Lectures in GERMAN and ENGLISH possible, abstracts in ENGLISH mandatory, in GERMAN optional, other languages possible in consultation with the organizing committee.
