SECOND CIRCULAR 2021

Subjects:

- The importance of archives, museums and collections for the development of earth sciences; Geological exploration and researchers in the Weinviertel and Waldviertel; Lower Austria

Organizational matters:

The original date for June 2020 had to be postponed to the same date but 2021 due to Corona. At the time of this 2nd circular, the circumstances for June 2021 are difficult to predict. Hence the delay with the 2nd circular.

Since severe travel restrictions are expected, the conference will take place digitally using ZOOM and on location. A conference in which participants are at different locations optically and acoustically connected to the meeting room using video technology. The access code will be sent by email prior to the conference.

The abstract volume will be completed shortly, printed and then sent together with other conference documents to all registered participants who have paid the conference fee.

Conference and excursion fees paid up to now have been carried over to the new date in June 2021. The excursion payments will be partially or fully reimbursed if the excursions are at least partially cancelled, as currently expected.

All those who have not yet paid the conference fee (or who have only now considered participating) are urgently requested to pay the amount of € 100 (students € 70) immediately. To be received by no later than April 15, 2021 (the edition of the abstract volume will be determined according to the conference fees paid).

In case you decide not to attend the conference the fees will be transferred back after the actual costs have been settled (abstract volume, postage, conference bag, possibly proceedings volume and other expenses).

Location of the conference and lectures:

The conference is partly planned in the rooms of the Krahuletz Museum (www.krahuletzmuseum.at/), but mostly in the ballroom of the town of Eggenburg (www.eggenburg.gv.at/).

Due to the corona, most excursions will probably have to be cancelled; precise planning is currently impossible.

Languages and speaking time:

Lectures are planned in German and English; speaking time is 20 minutes plus 5 minutes of discussion. It is possible to give individual presentations with double speaking time (but only by prior arrangement with the Organizing Committee by May 25, 2021).

The planned public evening lecture must be cancelled.
