Planned Lectures and Posters

The symposium will feature presentations on the following topics:

Natural and Cultural Heritage in Geology, Mining, and Metallurgy

Focus on iron processing in the context of sustainability and mobility (archives, collections, museums, etc.). Special attention will be given to topics related to rock formation and mineral utilization, including lead and gemstones, historical collections that reveal geological history and help identify global climate change patterns, as well as individual researchers' contributions.

Future Perspectives on Historical Knowledge

Emphasis on historical knowledge and traditions concerning mineral processing methods, machinery and equipment used, laboratory devices, industrial architecture, and innovations. This section also addresses questions about future natural resource utilization, types of work, and workers' positions.

Cultural Heritage as Economic Development Driver

Cultural heritage of geology, mining, and metallurgy forms the foundation of economic, social, and cultural development (tourism, agriculture, cultural creation, gastronomy, etc.) in European and non-European countries. Research and interpretation of this heritage provide opportunities for revitalizing degraded industrial areas and transforming them into spaces for connection and new opportunities for various creators.

Digitization of Geological, Mining, and Metallurgical Heritage

Digitization of maps, plans, field journals, documents, images, and photographs enables visual interpretation of heritage and database creation. Virtual tours through mines, smelters, and other metal processing and refining sites enrich the cultural heritage experience.

Intangible Heritage

Knowledge, inventions, and skills related to the extraction, preservation, and research of geological, mining, and metallurgical heritage. This includes terminology and sensory elements that help recognize work processes, hazards, and create a sense of familiarity.

Open Topics

Additional relevant presentations are welcome.

Presentation Format: Each contribution is allocated 15 minutes, with 5 minutes reserved for discussion.

The ERBE Symposium offers a rich and varied program, combining professional lectures, workshops, excursions, and cultural events. Participants will have the opportunity to engage in diverse activities throughout the week – from the opening reception to expert presentations, workshops, concerts, and visits to prominent regional sites.
